

2021 SNA total energy

Over 80% of our energy is generated from renewable or alternative fuels. Our 2025 goal is to decrease specific total energy (GJ/mt) by 5% from a 2019 baseline. Our total on-site renewable energy use is 70.5% with an additional 10.1% of renewable and clean energy as part of our purchased power for a total of 80.6%.



Decarbonization and partnership for transparency

Sappi has signed a letter of commitment to join the Science Based Targets initiative, which requires companies to set and meet GHG emission reduction targets for 2030 and 2050. This goal is to keep the global temperature increase well below 2°C compared with preindustrial temperatures. We have also expanded our carbon reporting to include Scope 3 emissions, seeking input from our suppliers so that we can develop reduction strategies for these emissions. This substantial effort will require full supply chain transparency, and we look forward to the enhanced partnership this will drive.

Keeping forests as forests

We act as champions for sustainable forestry—working to keep forestland forested for generations to come. Taking an active role in management can improve the health and wellbeing of the forest by mitigating conditions that make the forest more susceptible to damage from fire, insects, or disease. We begin by partnering with landowners to create a healthy plan for growth, harvest, and regeneration so they can reinvest in their forests instead of selling their land for agriculture or business development.

Ideas that Matter

Since 1999, Sappi's Ideas that Matter program has granted nearly \$14 million to support a wide range of initiatives that have a direct impact on social causes, ranging from sustainable food systems to healthcare to climate change. The program has been expanded to employees in North America, providing direct funding to nonprofit organizations that Sappi employees are most passionate about.
